
## 2024 June Primary and November General Elections Political Party Ballot Access Quick Look One Pager

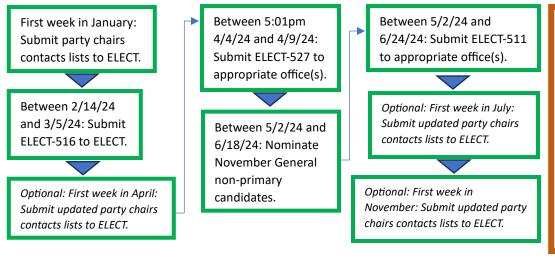
