

COMMONWEALTH of VIRGINIA STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS

DECISION ON APPEAL

In the matter of the campaign finance penalty appeal by Kiesha Preston For Delegate (CC-25-00177) November 17, 2025

FACTS

The above-named petitioner had a campaign finance report due on September 15, 2025, at 11:59:59 PM. Petitioner submitted the required report on September 22, 2025, at 1:49 AM. A \$1,000 civil penalty for failure to file a required report was issued by ELECT on September 16, 2025, at 12:09 AM.

Pursuant to § 24.2-953.6 of the Code of Virginia (the Code), petitioner submitted a *Petition to Appeal Campaign Finance Penalty* to the State Board of Elections (SBE) on September 22, 2025. Petitioner sought relief in the form of "forgiveness of the assessed penalty." Petitioner's basis for appeal was that circumstances made filing the required report or requesting an extension by the deadline impracticable. Petitioner stated that good cause existed to provide relief due to health complications.

DECISION

The SBE heard the appeal on November 17, 2025. Pursuant to § 24.2-953.6 of the Code, the SBE determined the petitioner demonstrated good cause to grant relief, not in the amount requested. but in the form of a reduction from \$1,000 to \$500.

RATIONALE

In finding that the petitioner demonstrated good cause, the SBE noted that the petitioner experienced health complications when the petitioner failed to file the required report. The SBE also noted that the petitioner has made efforts to prevent further incidents of noncompliance in the future.
