

# RANKED CHOICE VOTING IN VIRGINIA

Ranked Choice Voting lets you rank candidates instead of voting for just one. **Here's how to mark your ballot.**

You must mark at least one candidate for your vote to count.

Each candidate can only be chosen once.

## Step 1

Mark your top candidate under **First Choice**.

## Step 2

Mark your next candidate under **Second Choice** (not required).

## Step 3

Mark your third candidate under **Third Choice** (not required), and so on.
